On Sunday, entries will be taken 9:00am – 9:45am and again on Sunday following the end of the AM show, closing 15 minutes prior to the start of the PM show.*

*NOTE: All entries must be complete and paid for at the time of entry or they cannot be accepted. Pre-entries open December 1, 2011.*

All ASCA registered dogs over 6 months old must show proof of registration. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or any person not in good standing with ASCA. **Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition, all exhibitors and/or owners for which a check has been returned will be reported to ASCA - NO EXCEPTIONS.** The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Any exhibitor/owner with a check returned must pay all future NorCal event fees by cash, money order, and/or cashier's check.

## SHOW RINGS & DAY SET UPS

The ring will be located in the livestock barn with dirt flooring. There will be limited room for day set ups in the same barn, so please be courteous of your space requirements and other exhibitors. There will be plenty of room to set up outside of the barn area as well. Set ups must be a minimum of 15 feet from the ring. There is limited electricity for grooming, so we ask that all exhibitors share with other competitors. The fairgrounds open at 7:00am; however, **no set ups are allowed in the livestock barn until 8:15a.m. on Saturday in order to allow for the show committee to set up for the show.**

#### **Directions to the Small Animal Clinic (as per the clinic website 04/14/11)**

Exit from Interstate 80 onto Highway 113 north (Woodland). Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Continue on Hutchinson through the first stop light, turn right at the second stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. Follow the signs for emergency clinic.
